

Book Club Discussion Questions for *All The Broken People*

1. *All The Broken People* is set in a small town in North Georgia. How did the setting and atmosphere of the book affect the mood and tone of the story? Did it create a sense of danger, mystery, dread or unease?
2. What did you think of the main character, Alice Bennett? Did she make any decisions that you didn't agree with in response to the conflict of the novel?
3. Addiction and family secrets are central themes in *All The Broken People*. How did Alice's history of alcoholism and her desire to keep her past from Will shape her actions and decisions throughout the story?
4. Most crime stories have a villain. Who is the villain in *All The Broken People*? Did you understand their motives? Did they have any redeeming qualities or human emotions?
5. *All The Broken People* has a very vocal anti-hero. Is Larry Lee a good guy or a bad guy? Would the story be the same without him?
6. Which character did you relate to or empathize with the most and why?
7. The true crime story involving the murder of Juanita Jones is incorporated into an otherwise fictional story. How did this story impact your reading and understanding of the story?
8. Are there any characters you wish you could have given advice to? What would you tell them?
9. What was the most memorable or shocking scene in the story and why?
10. What was the most satisfying or disappointing part of the story and why?
11. *All The Broken People* is a standalone novel. How did you feel about the ending? Was it satisfying? Did it leave you with unanswered questions?
12. What do you think happens to the characters after the story ends?
